

MINUTES OF TERRITORIAL AERONAUTICAL COMMISSION MEETING  
HELD AT THE HONOLULU ARMORY ON TUESDAY AFTERNOON,  
NOVEMBER 22, 1927, AT 3:00 P. M.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the status of air-ports and landing fields throughout the territory.

MAUI: The Commission studied sketches of the proposed landing fields at Lahaina and Wailuku. Mr. Bailey informed the Acting Chairman that the transfer of land in connection with the above mentioned fields should be completed by the first of the coming year. Mr. Crawford states that he is not pleased with the proposed landing field at Hana and that it is not worth spending much money on the field. X


KAUAI: The Army Field at Hanapepe is ready and is now being used. It is about 150 to 200 feet wide and about 1,000 feet long. Mr. Charles Fern of Lihue suggests we have the Barking Sands Field set aside. The Acting Chairman has written to Mr. Lindsay Faye of Kekaha asking if he approves having this field set aside. In connection with the Wailua Field, the railroad is willing to move its tracks, put in a ditch, and do the grading for approximately \$15,000.00. The following motion was made by Mr. Van Valkenburg, seconded and unanimously carried: "The Acting Chairman is authorized to write to Mr. Bigelow to go ahead with the work on the Wailua Field". The Acting Chairman will request Mr. Bailey to set aside the Barking Sands Field for the use of this Commission. X
