Inspection of John Rogers Airport:

The Commission inspected the lay-out of the John Rogers Airport and checked the proposed location of the hangar for the Inter Island Airways as shown on the blue prints of the field.

Mr. Damon moved, seconded by Mr. Wooldridge that the location of the Inter Island Airways hangar as shown on the blue prints and as staked out on the ground be approved and that the Superintendent of Public Works be so informed.


Discussion of proposed new run-way:

The Chairman pointed out the necessity for having a run-way connecting with the leeward end of the present completed run-way of the hangar sites so that taxiing machines would not traverse the flying field and so that machines leaving the hangar to load up or take off could reach the leeward end of the run-way with greatest ease.

Dr. Hagood moved, seconded by Mr. Damon that the above mentioned run-way as shown on the blue prints of the field be authorized and that the Superintendent of Public Works be informed that the Commission desires work on same expedited. Carried. ✓
