This was a special meeting called by the Chairman to discuss the electric and water supply of John Rodgers Airport.

Report of the Chairman after conference with Mr. McIntyre: -- in re electric and water supply of John Rodgers Airport:

The Chairman reported that after conference with Mr. McIntyre, field manager for the S. M. Damon estate, that that gentleman had informed him that the Damon estate was prepared to furnish potable water from their supply, not to exceed 40 thousand gallons a day, at 20¢ per thousand gallons; that Mr. McIntyre also stated that the Commission could hook on to the Damon estate electric power line near the boundary of the airport provided the Commission would agree to bear its pro rata share of the installation of line and poles from the main line to the boundary of the airport.

It was moved by Mr. Wooldridge and seconded by Mr. Peacock that the Chairman take these matters up immediately with Mr. Lyman Bigelow of the Harbor Commissioners and expedite the installation of water and electric current onto the airport.

There was some discussion of the feasibility of the installation of an electric pump to flood the field with salt water as a binder of the surface dust.

Removal of old Lewis hangar:


Moved by Mr. Wooldridge and seconded by Mr. Damon that the Planning Committee take up the matter of the removal of the old Lewis hangar and other obstructions from the vicinity of the runway. Carried.

Discussion of a watchman for John Rodgers Airport:

The question of a watchman was again brought up by the Chairman and the Chairman was instructed to take up the feasibility of employing a watchman and report at the next meeting.
