

AIRPORT ZONING BOARD
PUBLIC HEARING - KONA, HAWAII
May 16, 1953

A public hearing of the Airport Zoning Board was called to order by Chairman George K. Houghtailing at the Court House, Kailua, Kona, Hawaii, May 16, 1953, at 10:35 a.m.

Mr. Houghtailing outlined the purpose of the hearing and called on Mr. Martin to explain some of the details of the proposed Airport Zoning Regulations and to show zoning maps.

After a brief general discussion, Mr. Houghtailing further pointed out that the Airport Zoning Board was very anxious to get the proposed regulations adopted so as to insure the future safety of airport approaches. He also stated that the Hawaii Aeronautics Commission was unable to secure certain Federal-Aid Funds from C.A.A. because of the lack of airport zoning.

Mr. Price and Mr. Tom Springer were the only two residents of Kona participating in this meeting. Mr. Price announced he would make a detailed report of the meeting through the Hilo Tribune so that it might be more widely brought to the attention of Kona residents.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
