There being no change in the minutes of the previous meeting, they were approved as circulated.

Hawaiian Airways Co., Ltd. -- in re hangar site:

The Chairman read a letter from the Hawaiian Airways Company making formal application for an allotment of hangar site at John Rogers Airport. After considerable discussion it was decided that this Company should be informed of the Commission's plans as to the location on the field of the hangars of the various operating air lines. ✓

Moved by Mr. Boyer and seconded by Mr. Brown that a letter be sent to the Hawaiian Airways Company, Limited such as was sent to the Inter Island Airways Company, Limited in re to hangar site, John Rogers Airport. Carried.

Discussion on Hilo Airport:

After general discussion by all members of the Commission, it was decided that the runway on the Hilo Airport was in an excellent condition and that the only immediate needed work was continuation of the present grading and filling so as to square out that side of the runway toward the city of Hilo.

Moved by Mr. Boyer and seconded by Mr. Peacock that a letter be addressed to the Jailer in Charge at Hilo Airport directing that the present runway be straightened out on the Hilo side and the present filling and grading operations be continued. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Damon and seconded by Mr. Peacock that the Board of Supervisors, island of Hawaii, be requested to remove the powder storage house from the Hilo Airport as soon as practicable. Carried. ✓

Moved by Dr. Hagood and seconded by Mr. Peacock that the hangar space as shown on the old Commission's map of Hilo Airport be assigned to the Inter Island Airways Co., Ltd. Carried.


MINUTES CONTINUED
