There being no changes in the minutes of the previous meeting, they were approved as circulated.

Report of Chairman on conferences had with Mr. Bigelow in re the electric and water supply for John Rodgers Airport:

The Chairman reported that Mr. Bigelow stated that he would keep after the matter of electric and water supply for John Rodgers Airport, and that he would see Mr. MacIntyre and the trustees of the Damon estate as soon as possible. ✓

There was considerable discussion about the proposition of watering the runways of John Rodgers Airport by pumping salt water onto them. The Chairman was instructed to cooperate with Mr. Bigelow and endeavor to procure a pump to experiment with sea water on a part of the runway.

Applicants for watchman for John Rodgers Airport:

The Chairman requested that any members of the Commission that might have in mind an applicant for the position of watchman for John Rodgers Airport to please send them up to him for interview; and in this connection reported that Mr. Bigelow had stated to him that it would be possible to move and improve the old wooden house on John Rodgers Airport so that it might be used as a watchman's residence temporarily. ✓

re license form to be issued the Inter Island Airways and the Hawaiian Airways, Ltd.

Moved by Mr. Boyer and seconded by Mr. Damon that the license form which had been presented to the Inter Island Airways and the Hawaiian Airways, Ltd. be again referred to the Attorney General with suggestions from this Commission for rearrangement. Carried.

Letter to Inter Island Airways:

Moved by Mr. Boyer and seconded by Mr. Peacock that a letter be addressed to the Inter Island Airways Co., Ltd. requesting that they submit their suggestions in connection with the franchise forms submitted for their consideration. Carried.

Roadway entrance to John Rodgers Airport:

Moved by Mr. Boyer and seconded by Mr. Peacock that the present roadway entrance to the John Rodgers Airport be considered as a permanent roadway and improved as such. Carried. ✓

Letter from the Hawaiian Airways, Ltd. attached to blueprint and specifications of their projected hangar for John Rodgers Airport. Same referred to Superintendent of Public Works for approval.

Letter from the Hawaiian Airways, Ltd. raising certain objections to suggested license form for hangar, machine shop, etc. for John Rodgers Airport.

Received a copy of the Third Annual Report of the former Aero Commission to be placed on file.


